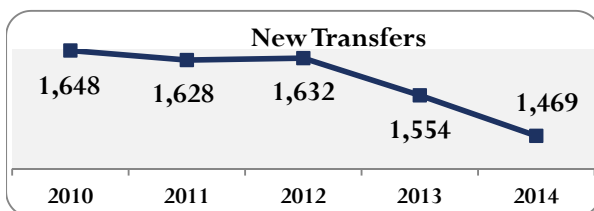

## 2014-2015 MINI FACT BOOK



### HIGHLIGHTS

- Enrollment for Fall 2014 is at an all-time high, with a total of 23,096 students -- an increase of 805 students or 3.6% over last fall.
- Enrollment has grown by an astounding 36.4% over the past decade, and by 18.2% in the past five years alone.
- UM's First Year retention rate jumped dramatically from 80.8% to 85.6% from Fall 2012 to Fall 2013 and held steady at 84.7% for the latest cohort.
- A record 2,984 students are enrolled at the UM Medical Center in Jackson, up by 124 students (4.2%) over last fall.
- For this year's freshmen class, the average ACT score is 24.3 and Overall High School GPA is 3.49 -- both of which are the highest in UM history.
- Demand remains strong at UM's Regional Campuses: Tupelo (711 students), DeSoto (653 students), Booneville (66 students), and Grenada (115 students).

## FIVE YEAR FALL ENROLLMENT TRENDS



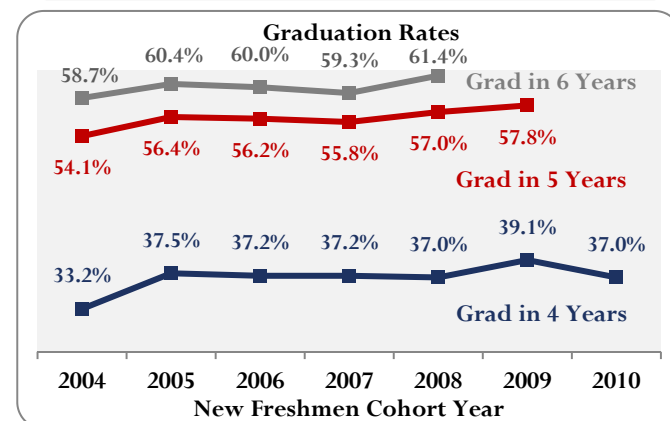
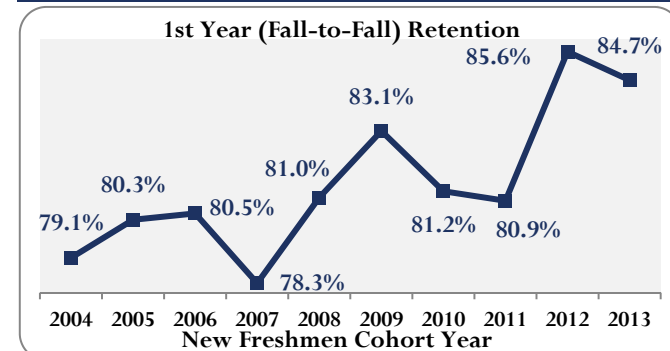
