

#### FIVE YEAR NEW FRESHMEN TRENDS





#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Enrollment for Fall 2011 is at an all-time high, with a total of 20,844 students -- an increase of 1,298 students or 6.6%.
- Enrollment has grown by an astounding 43.8% over the past decade, growing from 14,284 in 2001.
- A record 2,620 students are enrolled at the UM Medical Center in Jackson, up by 165 students (6.7%) over last fall.
- This fall's student body includes 3,569 new freshmen, an increase of 15.3% over last fall when UM enrolled the largest freshmen class in Mississippi history.
- The average ACT score of this year's freshmen class is 23.5 which is the highest in UM history.
- Demand remains strong at UM's satellite campuses: Tupelo (856 students), Southaven (968 students), Booneville (89 students), and Grenada (89 students).
